4. Teaching Subjects: Mathematics. (Lectures, exercise classes and seminars for Undergraduate and Graduate School of Mathematics.)
5. Qualifications: (i) Doctoral degree of Mathematics.
(ii) Japanese proficiency to teach classes in Japanese.
6. Starting Date: Not before October 1st, 2024 and as soon as possible when available.
7. Employment Status: Tenured.
