	specific terms and expressions to conduct a conference, and practice their
	knowledge during the preparatory course (see the syllabus of the course 01ZZ331).
	Through the participation in the TEMUN committee, students will practice their
	leadership skills, will plan and implement PR strategies and thus, will learn to
	overcome own passivity and fears and to become actively engaged during the event.
	During the TEMUN conference (see the syllabus of the course 01ZZ321), students
	will aim to formally speak and behave, in experiencing to carry out a conference
	following the rules of procedure. After TEMUN, there will be a post-event meeting
	for reviewing the experience.
